#### President's Message – Winter 2019

The Scarborough Cross Country Ski Club started in 1978 with the help of the Scarborough Rec and Parks Department. The purpose of the club is to provide skiing opportunities to its members in a social setting. We are all looking forward to skiing this winter! Hopefully we will have a more consistent winter weather pattern this year. The price of the bus portion of the ski trip will remain at \$25 and \$30 for walk ons and non-members. Guests are welcome but must send in cheques to reserve a seat. The destinations on the schedule are a rough guide to where we intend to go. The destination can change without notice for many reasons including better conditions elsewhere and rebalancing the schedule.

The last two seasons have been very disappointing because of variable weather and unsafe conditions. A record number of ski trips were canceled last year, mostly due to safety concerns which includes; icy track conditions, freezing rain, minus 20 temperatures and forecasts for rain. Last year the weather had a 7-day cycle with very little snow, followed by rain, followed by a hard freeze into the weekend. That meant the trails became skating rinks on Saturday. While it is disappointing to miss the trip, it doesn't make a lot of sense to waste a whole Saturday chasing conditions that are marginal, at best.

We try to cancel busses as early as possible to allow you to make alternate plans for the weekend. Cancellations will be posted on the Web-site followed by an e-mail. Check your spam folder if you are not receiving my messages. For scheduled trips, I try to send an email on Thursday or Friday, confirming the venue and the trail fee, so you can have the exact change available for trail fees. Legal tender under a loonie is highly discouraged. Cancellation date and time has been revised to **Tuesday Midnight**, prior to the planned trip. The best way to cancel is to email me at <a href="mailto:jhackert@scarboroughskiclub.org">jhackert@scarboroughskiclub.org</a>. After Tuesday, your cheque will be cashed. Early cancellation provides an opportunity for those on the waiting list to take your place, as all our trips are fully booked. We strive to fill all empty seats and give someone else on the waiting list a chance to ski.

Some have asked why we don't accept e-transfers or PayPal and insist on cheques? If we cancel a trip we don't have to reverse entries individually or provide refunds. I just start a fire in the fireplace and dispose of your uncashed cheque. The cost of cheques is about equal to the cost of PayPal. The Outing Club of East York will be sharing our bus again this year. We will pick OCEY skiers at York Mills station. After skiing, we will stop at Centennial first and then York Mills. Parking is free at Centennial. Please make OCEY members feel welcome. I will continue to save a few seats to accommodate couples getting on at York Mills.

Last year we only had one barbeque, in which everyone appreciated the upgraded vintage wine and gourmet quality sausages and condiments served. The extravagance will continue in spite of the substantial increase in cost. Subject to instructor availability, lessons are available for free for beginner skiers or those wishing to improve technique. If you are a beginner, you should come every week to develop your skills. Don't expect

much improvement if you leave a long interval between lessons. The primary goal of our lessons is to make you feel confident and safe engaging in a sport which is susceptible to falls and injury. Be sensible about strapping boards to your feet, so you can easily slide downhill in the snow.

Try to remember to wear your nametag. If your nametag has disappeared, contact George Duguay on the bus and he will make up a new nametag for you, at no cost.

Think snow — North of Highway 7!

#### HOW TO ENSURE RESERVATIONS FOR BUS TRIPS

You can register by mail for a bus trip (No cash Please!) for \$25.00 and your cheque will reserve your seat on the bus.

We will require separate cheques for each bus trip. Be sure to indicate the destination on your cheque as indicated on the Schedule of Events, and <u>note your phone number and e-mail address</u>. In the case of poor ski conditions, do not phone us to inquire if the bus has been cancelled. WE WILL E-MAIL YOU and note the cancellation on Facebook and the web-site.



The cost for each bus trip is \$25.00. Many of our members mail all of their cheques at one time for the entire a season to reserve their seats. If there is space on the bus, skiers who have not sent in their cheques will be charged \$30.00.

If you wish to cancel a reservation, you must do so by midnight on Tuesday before the trip by e-mailing John at: jhackert@scarboroughskiclub.org to cancel any pre-scheduled bus trip. Your subject line should be: SCCSC Cancellation—and should note the trip date, the intended destination and the number of people cancelling.

All buses leave Centennial Recreation Centre promptly at 8:00 a.m. with a 2nd pick up at York Mills TTC Station. Please be early to allow time to load your skis. The trail fees range from \$16 to \$20 and we collect these cash fees (exact change, nothing smaller than a loonie) on the bus.

A separate cheque for each ski event, dated the date of the trip, with your phone number as well as your e-mail address, if applicable, noting the destination on the front of your cheque, will continue to ensure the success of our ski bus trips.
